SOCIAL MEETING 24TH NOVEMBER 2020

A purely social meeting with no business was enjoyed by 15 members on a balmy evening. Even our usually enthusiastic photographer had the night off. However, Keith Miller gave me the photograph below, and Ted Pickering has written a few lines about the historic visit depicted.



The photo depicted the **1990 Rotary Group Study team**, from Columbia (South America), outside the **RAAF School of Photography** at RAAF East Sale, during their visit to the RAAF Base.

The GSE Team is in the foreground and in the back row are from the left- **Wing Commander Keith Miller**, then Senior Admin Officer RAAF East Sale, **Ted Pickering** ex-RAAF Photographer, then International Service Director, Rotary Club of Sale Central and on the right **Squadron Leader Wally Walton**, then CO of the RAAF School of Photography. Significantly, this photo was taken as the group started their tour of the school and the prints were presented to them as they left, less than an hour later! In the pre-digital photo era this was impressive. After the photo was taken the film had to be developed, washed and dried (all in the dark). Then the best negative selected, put in the enlarger, the colour balanced

and printed. Once again into the darkroom to process wash and dry the print and check it for quality, colour, contrast etc. Once satisfied, a set of prints would be printed, washed, dried, trimmed and packaged for presentation! In 1990 to do all this in less than an hour was most unusual.

The Group Study Team were the guests of Rotary District 9820, and the Rotary Club of Sale Central hosted them whilst in the Sale/Maffra area. They spent 6 weeks in District 9820 and attended the District Conference before returning home. Ted Pickering.

P.S. the editor was also told that the gentleman on the left was a surgeon in Columbia, who had a great deal of experience removing bullets as gun crime was rife there, and that another of our visitors was a priest.

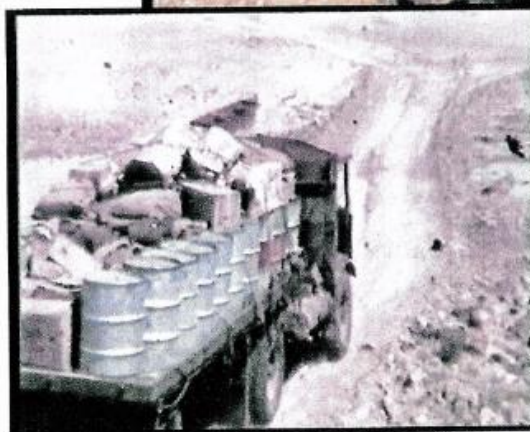

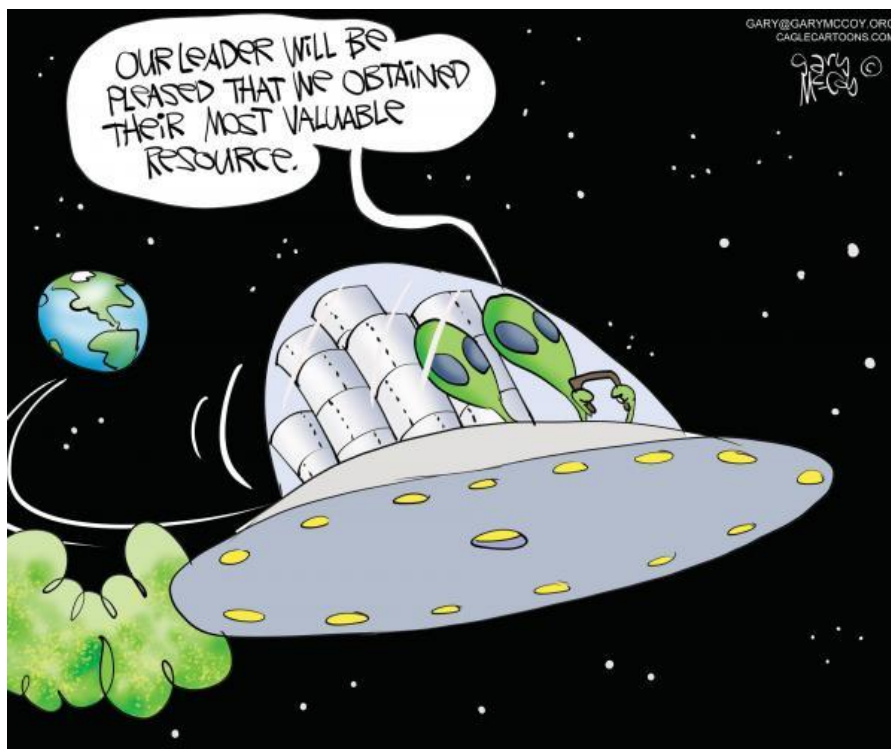
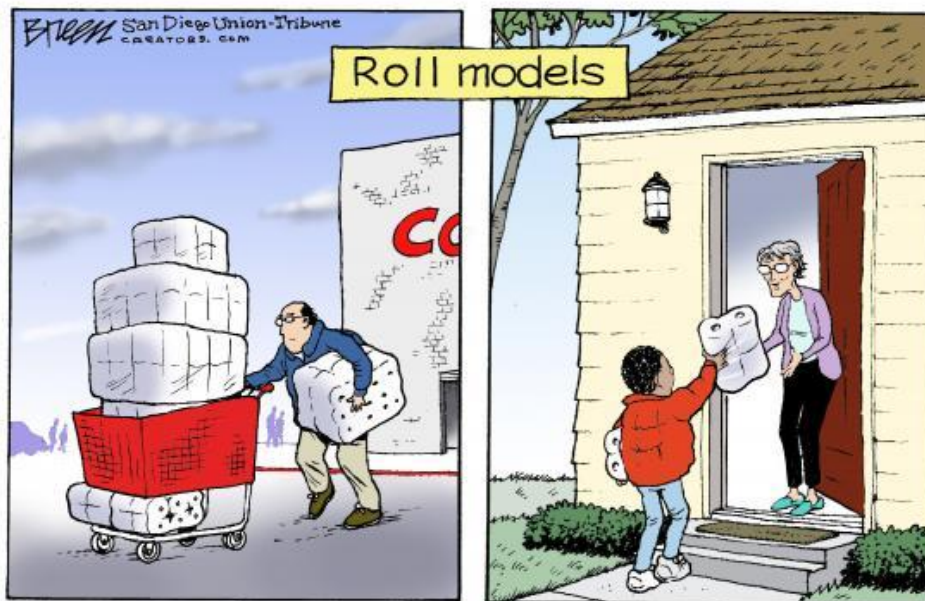
