President Philip said that getting stuck into some fundraising would be

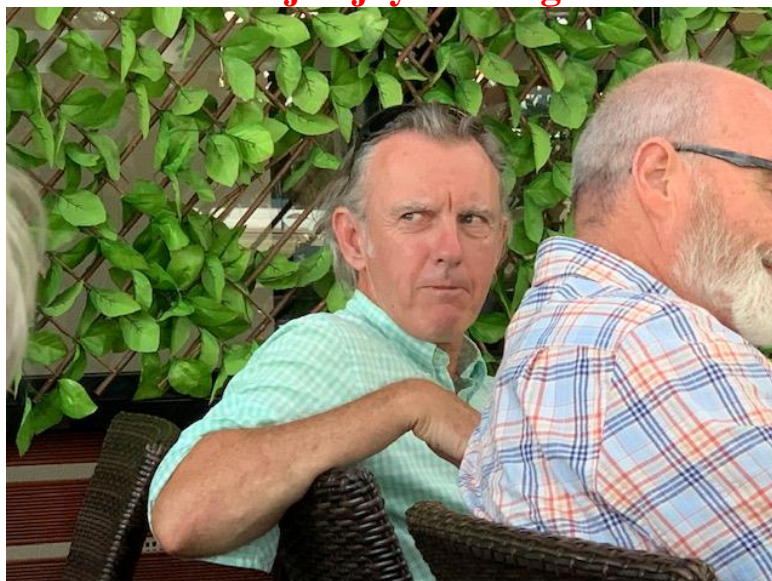

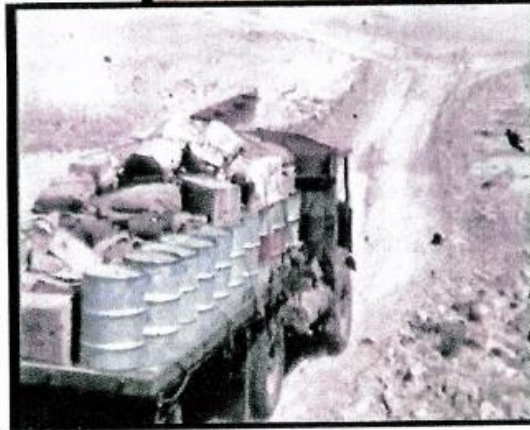
